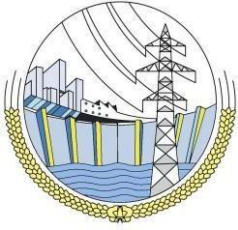

1. The Government of Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received a credit from International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Dasu Hydropower Stage-I Project. Funds for carrying out the Resettlement Sites Infrastructure Development schemes have been allocated in approved PC-I (March 2014) of Dasu HPP.
2. The Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (The Employer) now, invites sealed Quotations from eligible bidders/vendors/nursery growers having valid registration with **Federal Seed Certification & Registration Department**, registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments and who are on Active Taxpayers List of the Federal Board of Revenue for **DIRECT SEED SOWING OF FOREST PLANTS AND WATCH & WARD FOR AFFORESTATION** which are to be completed in 1215 days.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the World Bank Procurement Procedure using Request for Quotations (RFQ) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" September 2023. ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the RFQ Document at the address given below during office hours (0830 hours – to 1630 hours).
4. The RFQ Documents in English may be obtained by the interested eligible bidders from the office of General Manager / Project Director, Dasu Hydropower Project WAPDA, Chuchang Colony, District Kohistan (Upper), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The RFQ Documents may also be downloaded from WAPDA website at www.wapda.gov.pk and Project website www.dasuhpp.com. Subsequently, Interested Bidders must acknowledge their participation in bidding procedure via email dasuhppsite@gmail.com and director.ehsdasuhpp@gmail.com at least 02 days before submission date for security and clearance purpose.
5. The Commencement of Work will effect from **15 November 2026**, and the Contractor shall be duly notified accordingly.
6. Sealed Bids/Quotations will be submitted in the above mentioned address on or before **18th May, 2026** up to **1200 hours** and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in an amount not less than **PKR 50,000/-** in the form of Unconditional Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled Bank in Pakistan or in the form of Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) in favour of **General Manager/Project Director, Dasu Hydropower Project WAPDA**. The sealed Bids/Quotations will be opened at **1230 hours** on the same date at the same place in the presence of the bidder's representatives who wish to participate and witness the opening. Instructions for Request for Quotation

1 Scope of Bid/Quotation

The Employer as defined in the Bidding Data (here in after called “the Employer”) wishes to receive Bid / Quotation for the works as summarized in the Bidding/Quotation Data (here in after referred to as “the Works”).

2 Eligibility of Bidders

Bidders shall be required to submit documentary evidence demonstrating their eligibility, including but not limited to the following:

- Certification and registration with the **Federal Seed Certification & Registration Department**;
- Valid registration with the **Federal Board of Revenue (FBR)** and/or the relevant **Provincial Tax Authority**;
- Possession of a valid **National Tax Number (NTN)** and status as an **Active Taxpayer**;
- Evidence of having successfully completed at least **three (03) contracts** involving the **Afforestation / supply or plantation of plants / Seed Sowing/Dibbling** during the last **five (05) years**; and
- **At least one (01) completed contract of similar nature, specifically involving the seed sowing/dibbling.**

Failure to submit the above documentation may result in disqualification from the bidding process.

3 Fraud and Corruption

The Bank requires compliance with the Bank’s Anti-Corruption Guidelines and its prevailing sanctions policies and procedures as set forth in the WBG’s Sanctions Framework, as set forth in Appendix A to the Contract Conditions. In further pursuance of this policy, Supplier/ Contractors shall permit and shall cause their agents (where declared or not), sub-contractors, sub-consultants, service providers, suppliers, and personnel, to permit the Bank to inspect all accounts, records and other documents relating to the RFQ and Contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank. Details of the World Bank Guideline for Fraud and Corruption is attached at Appendix-A of this RFQ.

4 Eligible Contractors

- i. In case the Contractor is a joint venture (JV), all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the entire Contract in accordance with the Contract terms. The JV shall nominate a representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the JV during the Request for Quotations process and, in the event the JV is awarded the Contract, during contract execution.
- ii. A Contractor may have the nationality of any country, subject to the restrictions given below. A Contractor shall be deemed to have the nationality of a country if the Contractor is constituted, incorporated or registered in, and operates in conformity with, the provisions of the laws of that country, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation (or equivalent documents of constitution or association) and its registration documents, as the case may be. This criterion also shall apply to the determination of the nationality of proposed subcontractors or sub-consultants for any part of the Contract including Related Services.
- iii. Firms and individuals may be ineligible if:
 - a. as a matter of law or official regulations, the Borrower’s country prohibits commercial relations with that country, provided that the Bank is satisfied that such exclusion does not preclude effective competition for the supply of goods or the contracting of works or services required; or

- b. by an act of compliance with a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, the Borrower's country prohibits any import of goods or contracting of works or services from that country, or any payments to any country, person, or entity in that country.
- iv. A Contractor that has been sanctioned by the Bank, pursuant to the Bank's Anticorruption Guidelines, in accordance with its prevailing sanctions policies and procedures as set forth in the WBG's Sanctions Framework as described in the appendix to the Contract Conditions (Appendix A) paragraph 2.2 d., shall be ineligible to submit Quotations or be awarded or otherwise benefit from a Bank-financed contract, financially or otherwise, during such period of time as the Bank shall have determined. A list of debarred firms and individuals is available on the Bank's external website: <http://www.worldbank.org/debarr>.
- v. Contractors that are state-owned enterprises or institutions in the Employer's country may be eligible to compete and be awarded a Contract(s) only if they can establish, in a manner acceptable to the Bank, that they:
 - a. are legally and financially autonomous;
 - b. operate under commercial law; and
 - c. are not under supervision of the Employer.
- vi. A Contractor shall not have a conflict of interest. Any Contractor found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Contractor may be considered to have a conflict of interest for the purpose of this Request for Quotations process, if the Contractor:
 - a. directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by or is under common control with another Contractor that submitted a Quotation;
 - b. receives or has received any direct or indirect subsidy from another Contractor that submitted a Quotation;
 - c. has the same legal representative as another Contractor that submitted a Quotation;
 - d. has a relationship with another Contractor that submitted a Quotation, directly or through common third parties, that puts it in a position to influence the Quotation of another Contractor, or influence the decisions of the Employer regarding this Request for Quotations process; or
 - e. any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the works that are the subject of the Request for Quotations process; or
 - f. any of its affiliates has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the Employer or Borrower for implementing the Contract; or
 - g. would be providing goods, works, or non-consulting services resulting from, or directly related to consulting services for the preparation or implementation of the project specified in this Request for Quotations, that it provided or were provided by any affiliate that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with that firm; or
 - h. has a close business or family relationship with a professional staff of the Borrower (or of the project implementing agency, or of a recipient of a part of the loan) who: (i) are directly or indirectly involved in the preparation of the Request for Quotations or specifications and/or the evaluation of Quotations, of the subject Contract; or (ii) would be involved in the implementation or supervision of such Contract unless the conflict stemming from such relationship has been resolved in a manner acceptable to the Bank throughout the Request for Quotations process and execution of the Contract.

5 Labour

- i. **Forced Labour.** The Contractor, including its Subcontractors, shall not employ or engage forced labor. Forced labor consists of any work or service, not voluntarily performed, that is exacted from an individual under threat of force or penalty, and includes any kind of involuntary or compulsory labor, such as indentured labor, bonded labor or similar labor-contracting arrangements. No persons shall be employed or engaged who have been subject to trafficking. Trafficking in persons is defined as the recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring or receipt of persons by means of the threat or use of force or other forms of coercion, abduction, fraud, deception, abuse of power, or of a position of vulnerability, or of the giving or receiving of payments or benefits to achieve the consent of a person having control over another person, for the purposes of exploitation. The contractor will fill and duly signed and stamped the standard Forms regarding the Forced Labour Performance Declaration and Forced Labor Declaration enclosed in Section III (Standard Forms) of this RFQ.
- ii. **Child Labour.** The Contractor, including its Subcontractors, shall not employ or engage a child under the age of 14 unless the national law specifies a higher age (the minimum age). The Contractor, including its Subcontractors, shall not employ or engage a child between the minimum age and the age of 18 in a manner that is likely to be hazardous, or to interfere with, the child's education, or to be harmful to the child's health or physical, mental, spiritual, moral, or social development.

The Contractor including its Subcontractors, shall only employ or engage children between the minimum age and the age of 18 after an appropriate risk assessment has been conducted by the Contractor with the Project Manager's approval. The Contractor shall be subject to regular monitoring by the Project Manager that includes monitoring of health, working conditions and hours of work. Work considered hazardous for children is work that, by its nature or the circumstances in which it is carried out, is likely to jeopardize the health, safety, or morals of children.

6 Preparation of Bid/Quotation

Bidder shall complete the Schedule of Price as mentioned in Quotation/Schedule of Price.

The quotation shall be submitted in Pakistani Rupees (PKR), inclusive of all applicable duties, taxes, levies, transportation costs to the designated site, and any other charges or obligations payable by the Supplier under the Contract. All such costs shall be deemed to be included in the total quoted price.

The rates quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the Contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.

Bidders are instructed to purchase of seeds of the forest plants species and supply to the designated site, seeds sowing operation in 20 acres selected area and watch & ward for three (03) years as per provided specification at Section IV of RFQ. Any deviation from given specification will not be accepted.

Each Bidder can submit only one quotation.

7 Deadline for Submission of Bid / Quotation

Bid/Quotation must be received by the Employer on or before of deadline and at the address detailed in Quotation Data.

Bid/Quotation will remain valid for Ninety (90) days after Bid/Quotation submission deadline. Each Bidder shall prepare Original and 02 numbers of copies as Specified in the Bidding Data and shall clearly mark them “ORIGINAL” and “COPY” as appropriate.

8 Evaluation of Bid / Quotations

The Office of General Manager / Project Director will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be:

- Substantially responsive;
- Properly signed and valid for minimum Ninety (90) days; and
- Conform to the terms and conditions and specifications.

9 Award of Contract

The Employer will award the Contract to the Bidder whose Bid / Quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the most advantageous Bid/Quotation.

Notwithstanding the above, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject quotation and to cancel the bidding process and reject all Bids/Quotations at any time prior to the Award of contract.

The Bidder whose Bid/Quotation is accepted will be notified of the Award of Contract by the Employer prior to expiration of the Bid/Quotation validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the Work/Purchase Order.

The Employer shall issue the commencement of work order to the Contractor and the seed sowing activity shall be executed within 05 days. The Contractor shall strictly adhere to and comply with the stipulated commencement date and execution timeline. The Commencement of Work shall be issued with effect from 15 November 2026, and the Contractor shall be duly notified. The Contractor shall execute the work strictly in accordance with such communicated commencement date.

10 Bid Security

The Bidders shall furnish, along with their Bids/Quotation, a Bid Security for an amount **PKR 50,000/-** in the form of Unconditional Bank Guarantee as per provided form at Section III (Standard Forms) / Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) issued by a scheduled Bank in Pakistan. In case of Foreign Bank, the guarantee shall be counter- guaranteed by a scheduled Bank in Pakistan. Guarantees from other financial institutions such as insurance, bonding or security companies shall not be permitted. The Bid Security shall be valid for Thirty (30) days beyond the original validity period of the Bid/Quotation. The Bid Security of Bidders shall be returned as promptly as possible upon the issuance of Work / Purchase Order to the successful Bidder.

11 Performance Security

Within five (05) days of the receipt of notification of award from the Employer, the successful Bidder shall furnish the Performance Security as per provided form at Section III (Standard Forms) of RFQ at 5% of the cost of Contract shall be applicable in the forms of a Bank Guarantee/CDR from Scheduled Bank valid up to completion of contract and shall be return back to the contractor upon completion of successful direct seed sowing work.

You are hereby communicated, arrange all necessary requirement, supply of the seeds according to the given specification and commenced the seeds sowing in the selected area of 20 Acre at _____ Tehsil _____ of the Project area on _____.

Terms and Conditions

1. The work should be started in the upcoming seed sowing season, therefore the commencement of work shall be started from 15 November 2026 and must be completed before 15 January 2027.
 2. Time for Completion for Direct Seed Sowing and Watch & Ward for Afforestation will be 1215 days from Commencement Date by the Contractor. In case of any delay the liquidated damages 0.033 percent per day of the Accepted Contract Price will be charged to the Contractor. The maximum amount of Liquidated Damages shall be 10 % of the Accepted Contract Price.
 3. Income tax and other applicable taxes will be deducted at source as per rules/ orders if applicable. Deduction of applicable taxes shall be done at the rates and as per procedures provided for in the relevant laws applicable at the time of each payment. Any tax exemption shall be subject to valid
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and verifiable substantiation document by the Contractor prior to request for payment.

4. Terms of Payment:

One hundred percent (100%) payment for each item/work related to the seed sowing operations including labour costs, seed costs, and other miscellaneous expenses (such as signboards and OHS requirements like PPE provision) shall be paid to the Contractor upon successful completion and verification of the work by the Employer's / Project Manager's representatives. Payment will be processed after submission of the Contractor's invoice along with required supporting documents, such as Purchase/Work Orders or Contract Agreement, and Delivery Challans, if applicable.

The remuneration for watcher engaged for watch and ward duties shall be paid on a monthly basis, upon the Contractor's request along with a satisfactory note from the owners. The Contractor's profit shall also be included in each invoice submitted by the Contractor, calculated on a percentage basis.

5. Termination clause:

The Employer or the supplier, by written notice may terminate the contract if the other party causes a breach of the Contract. In case of termination of the Contract by the Employer on the Contractor's default, the performance security submitted by the Contractor would be forfeited.

6. Extension of Time for Completion:

The General Manager / Project Director shall determine and authorize any Extension of Time with or without any additional cost for delivery upon Contractor request for a decision and submitting full supporting information. Request for Extension of Time shall be submitted prior to the expiry of Completion Time.

ENVIORNMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Environmental Consideration

Environmental considerations are focused on minimizing harm to ecosystems, conserving resources, and promoting sustainable development. When distributing fruit plants, it is crucial to evaluate the environmental impact to ensure the process is both sustainable and beneficial to the local ecosystem.

The seed sowing of forest plant species benefits the environment by sequestering carbon, improving air quality, and enhancing soil health. It prevent erosion, conserve water, and enrich the soil while supporting biodiversity by providing habitats for wildlife. Additionally, it help regulate the microclimate by offering shade, cooling the environment, and reducing the heat island effect. Seed sowing is an environmentally friendly initiative that significantly contributes to biodiversity conservation. By afforestation through seed sowing attracting pollinators, play a vital role in enhancing local biodiversity while also providing essential shelter and food sources for native wildlife.

However, the seed sowing for afforestation may have some negative environmental impacts. Therefore, the following environmental factors have been carefully considered during the planning, decision-making, and implementation processes for purchase, supply and seed sowing operation.

1. Plant Species Selection

Supply of native or locally-adapted seeds of the plant species has been prioritized to support local biodiversity and ecosystems. The invasive species of fruit plants have been avoided in the direct seed sowing. These plant species are suited to the local climate and soil conditions.

2. Soil and Land Suitability

It has been ensured that the selected forest plant species are well-suited and compatible with the soil conditions in the intended sowing area. The sowing area are prioritized where afforestation through seed sowing can contribute to soil stabilization and help prevent erosion. It will be ensured to prevent land overuse or deforestation.

3. Pesticide and Fertilizer Use

The area designated for seed sowing practices to avoid the use of toxic chemicals and pesticides for pest control. However, it is important to further promote organic farming methods to reduce chemical runoff and prevent soil contamination.

4. Transportation and Carbon Footprint

The seeds will be purchased/procured from nearby areas/nurseries to reduce transportation emissions. The biodegradable or reusable materials will be used during the work.

5. Waste Management

All waste generated at direct seed sowing site including plastic pots, polythene bags, damaged tools, paper, and other materials, must be properly managed and responsibly

disposed up after the successful completion of the work. The appropriate waste management practices will be carried out to minimize environmental impact and ensure cleanliness at the sites.

6. Climate Resilience

The selection of species for seed sowing has been based on climate resilience factors. Direct seed sowing for afforestation on the hilly eroded area is an active measure that contributes to carbon absorption and biodiversity enhancement.

APPENDIX A

TO CONTRACT CONDITIONS

Fraud and Corruption

(Text in this Appendix shall not be modified)

1. Purpose

1.1 The Bank's Anti-Corruption Guidelines and this annex apply with respect to procurement under Bank Investment Project Financing operations.

2. Requirements

2.1 The Bank requires that Borrowers (including beneficiaries of Bank financing); bidders (applicants/proposers), consultants, contractors and suppliers; any sub-contractors, sub-consultants, service providers or suppliers; any agents (whether declared or not); and any of their personnel, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process, selection and contract execution of Bank-financed contracts, and refrain from Fraud and Corruption.

2.2 To this end, the Bank:

a. Defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

- i. "corrupt practice" is the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party;
- ii. "fraudulent practice" is any act or omission, including misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
- iii. "collusive practice" is an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including to influence improperly the actions of another party;
- iv. "coercive practice" is impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party;
- v. "obstructive practice" is:
 - (a) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering, or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede a Bank investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive, or collusive practice; and/or threatening, harassing, or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or

- (b) acts intended to materially impede the exercise of the Bank's inspection and audit rights provided for under paragraph 2.2 e. below.
- b. Rejects a proposal for award if the Bank determines that the firm or individual recommended for award, any of its personnel, or its agents, or its sub-consultants, sub-contractors, service providers, suppliers and/ or their employees, has, directly or indirectly, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for the contract in question;
- c. In addition to the legal remedies set out in the relevant Legal Agreement, may take other appropriate actions, including declaring misprocurement, if the Bank determines at any time that representatives of the Borrower or of a recipient of any part of the proceeds of the loan engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices during the procurement process, selection and/or execution of the contract in question, without the Borrower having taken timely and appropriate action satisfactory to the Bank to address such practices when they occur, including by failing to inform the Bank in a timely manner at the time they knew of the practices;
- d. Pursuant to the Bank's Anti-Corruption Guidelines and in accordance with the Bank's prevailing sanctions policies and procedures, may sanction a firm or individual, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, including by publicly declaring such firm or individual ineligible (i) to be awarded or otherwise benefit from a Bank-financed contract, financially or in any other manner;¹ (ii) to be a nominated² sub-contractor, consultant, manufacturer or supplier, or service provider of an otherwise eligible firm being awarded a Bank-financed contract; and (iii) to receive the proceeds of any loan made by the Bank or otherwise to participate further in the preparation or implementation of any Bank-financed project;
- e. Requires that a clause be included in bidding/request for proposals documents and in contracts financed by a Bank loan, requiring (i) bidders (applicants/proposers), consultants, contractors, and suppliers, and their sub-contractors, sub-consultants, service providers, suppliers, agents personnel, permit the Bank to inspect³ all accounts, records and other documents relating to the procurement process, selection and/or contract execution, and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank.

¹ For the avoidance of doubt, a sanctioned party's ineligibility to be awarded a contract shall include, without limitation, (i) applying for pre-qualification, expressing interest in a consultancy, and bidding, either directly or as a nominated sub-contractor, nominated consultant, nominated manufacturer or supplier, or nominated service provider, in respect of such contract, and (ii) entering into an addendum or amendment introducing a material modification to any existing contract.

² A nominated sub-contractor, nominated consultant, nominated manufacturer or supplier, or nominated service provider (different names are used depending on the particular bidding document) is one which has been: (i) included by the bidder in its pre-qualification application or bid because it brings specific and critical experience and know-how that allow the bidder to meet the qualification requirements for the particular bid; or (ii) appointed by the Borrower.

³ Inspections in this context usually are investigative (i.e., forensic) in nature. They involve fact-finding activities undertaken by the Bank or persons appointed by the Bank to address specific matters related to investigations/audits, such as evaluating the veracity of an allegation of possible Fraud and Corruption, through the appropriate mechanisms. Such activity includes but is not limited to: accessing and examining a firm's or individual's financial records and information, and making copies thereof as relevant; accessing and examining any other documents, data and information (whether in hard copy or electronic format) deemed relevant for the investigation/audit, and making copies thereof as relevant; interviewing staff and other relevant individuals; performing physical inspections and site visits; and obtaining third party verification of information.
